For USA 5.0 lbs/gal (600 g/L) VOC compliant rules (National Rule Only):

- Reduce 10% with 170 or 170HP Series Reducers listed above
- For best performance, activate eight (8) parts 327 Color with one (1) part HPC1 Activator Medium prior to reduction

NOTE: Choose reducer based on temperature and size of part to be finished

- · Indefinite without activator
- · Four (4) Hours with activator
